ORDER

Pursuant to the inherent powers of this court and Uniform Superior Court Rule 1.2 and in order to provide for an understandable, efficient and inexpensive resolution of disputes, this local rule is promulgated.

SECTION 1. This rule applies to all parties in **all divorce, separate maintenance, paternity, change of custody, visitation, legitimation and other domestic relations actions**, excluding domestic violence and contempt actions, filed on or after September 1, 1991, where the interests of children under 18 years of age are involved.

SECTION 2. All parties shall successful complete the program entitled "Children of Divorce Education Program". See "Appendix A" which describes the program and which is attached hereto and incorporated herein by express reference.


SECTION 3. The program shall be successfully completed within 31 days of service of the original complaint upon the original defendant.

SECTION 4. Upon a party's failure to successfully complete the program to this rule, the assigned judge may take appropriate action, including but not limited to actions for contempt.


